

# **TRANSIT STRIKE CONTINGENCY PLAN**

## **Introduction**

This contingency plan reflects the Citywide policy should a transit strike occur in the City.

## **Schedule of Changes**

Beginning with the first day of a strike, until further notice, all student regular start times will be delayed for two (2) hours. School staff should report as early as possible, but no later than one (1) hour after their regular scheduled start time.

## **Citywide Announcement to Change School Schedules**

School staff and parents should be advised to listen to information broadcast by any of the following radio stations: WINS (1010 AM), WCBS (880 AM), WLIB (1190 AM), WBLS (107.5), WNYE (91.5), as well as the following television stations: WCBS (Channel 2), WNBC (Channel 4), WNYW (Channel 5), WABC (Channel 7), WNYE (Channel 25), and "NY 1" (Channel 1 on cable television).

Schedule changes and other relevant information will also be posted with New York City's 311 line. The 311 service provides translation as needed into any of 150+ languages.

## **Special Considerations**

It is essential that parents and staff be made aware that, in all instances of an approved and authorized delayed school opening, all field trips will be cancelled.

All after-school recreational as well as non-credit-bearing instructional programs will be cancelled. Unless otherwise noted, High School evening classes and credit-bearing programs will operate at their scheduled times. College Now classes will run.

## **School Activities During the Day of an Authorized Citywide Change in Schedules**

All school staff have the responsibility and obligation to report to work as early as possible but not later than one (1) hour after the regular reporting time.

Regular attendance reporting standards apply (absences, lateness) based on the later starting time.

## **Dismissals from School**

It is expected that schools will adhere to the regular dismissal time. In the event that conditions warrant it, the Chancellor will notify all superintendents, radio and television media and 311, and bus services of an earlier dismissal schedule. Parents should be advised to discuss contingency plans with their children in case children are released early and parents are not at home to care for them. Parents should be further advised to listen to any of the following radio stations listed above to be informed of any early dismissal.
